He has presented lectures on equine dentistry at a wide array of conferences including the IGFP in Germany, the NVVGP in the Netherlands, the BAEDT in the United Kingdom, IBVET in Brazil, the Texas Equine Veterinary Association, the American Association of Equine Practitioners, the Louisiana Veterinary Medical Association, Western Veterinary Conference, the International Association of Equine Dentistry and many others. He has published several peer-reviewed articles in different areas of equine dentistry.
